TODAY'S MESSAGE

THE LIGHT OF LIFE

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Today I am going to talk about the life there is in Christ and what He has promised us from before time.

In the Bible study this week I talked about life and what life is. I am going to just be quite blunt today and just say what I believe and what is in my heart. Let this be thought from where you can study Scripture. One thing I want you to know is that this ministry or who I am is not here to try to shock people. My heart is not to shock anybody. My heart is to preach the truth as it is written in the Bible and I thank God for His grace.

I would like to ask those of you who pray for me, thank you for praying for me, like Paul said, "That I can have an open door to preach this Word and that I can be strengthened in my heart to preach this Word. Many times when I see certain things in the Bible, I become a bit battered by persecution and then I think, "I don't know if I must say it because it is just going to cause, again, a fight from the beginning. I am just launching Jesus in the title, and now I'm talking about immortality. You can just cause yourself a tremendous amount of trouble. But let that be! It's not about if we have trouble or we don't have trouble. It's about the truth and ministering the truth to people.

What I am going to explain to you today is that God's dream for you, from the beginning, was that you would have immortality. You might say, "We are all immortal." We talk about the immortal soul. If we talk about the immortal soul what does the Bible mean when it says, "Both soul and body can be destroyed in hell," if the soul is so immortal? What I think has happened to the Church is that we have taken immortality just as a given and not as a gift. What God has come to give us is His life. What I am about to share with you is going to change the whole foundation from where you read the Gospel, read the Bible. As you see this, you will start to see that it is actually written everywhere and that everything revolves around this.

You might say, “Bertie, how does that relate to good news and all of that if God has just come to give us immortality? How can that be good news?” I think immortality is very good news for a mortal. So if you are mortal and God grants us immortality as a free gift, it changes everything. And what it also is going to change is it will change your view of the after life. It's going to change your view of what happens to unbelievers when they die. It's going to change your view of what happens to the believer when he dies and what happens in the return of Christ. It's going to change your whole view about the vision that God has for us. As you listen to these messages every Sunday, it might take some time for you to “catch the drift,” to know what it is actually all about. But the moment you get that, you will start to realize how good God is, how God is not sin conscious, how God is not against you, how God can never, EVER kill any person, how He cannot punish you, how He cannot bring pain and hardship over your life, how He's not the author of any confusion, how there is no condemnation for you in Christ Jesus and how we can actually live towards the world and see the world and walk with an absolute passion for life towards them and share good news, the good news of God's love to them.

As I share this message of life, you might even ask yourself the question, “How do I evangelize because my evangelism has always been the message of, “You deserve to go to hell and be tortured eternally and now God can save you by putting Jesus in hell for three days, not eternally, just for three days. He was tortured there and now He came out and now you cannot be tortured if you believe in Jesus.” It's a message that sounds like good news but it contradicts itself because if I tell you that I have created a heaven and a hell and then I had to create somebody to either be in heaven or in hell. Then I created man because, actually, in my back pocket I had a fruit that nobody should eat from but I didn't have somebody who could eat of it and who I can actually test, so then He created man. Then man ate of the wrong fruit and then he deserved to be punished by God in eternal hell and to be eternally tormented by God in hell.

You must remember if hell destroys and you die in hell, or you are being destroyed in hell, who keeps you alive if God is the only one who possesses life? It has to be God who keeps you alive in that torment. So when we look at that and then we say, “This God loves you so much that He will save you from the hell that He created to punish you in if you should disobey Him. “You hear that it is very good news not to go to hell but it's not as good news to actually have something to do with this God because this God has some weird ideas! He's not like us. He has a goodness about him. He has a kindness about him but it's not in the light of in the parameters that we can actually understand.

So, when you hear this message of life, be ready to be challenged in what you believe. I want to tell you, in preaching this, I'm making myself ready to see people's lives completely changed and joy explode in the hearts of 1 people as well as some folk who obviously will not understand because the Scripture says, “If they hear the Father, they will hear you and if they don't hear the Father, they also will not hear you.” That is sad because we want as many people as possible to hear this message.

Let us start at the beginning. Let us start with a passionate message of life that comes from God.

Titus 1

:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;

:2 In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

The way we defined eternal life was not eternal existence, but to be eternally alive, but the way we have defined it was going to heaven. That is basically how we have defined eternal life. Some would define it because the Bible says in **John 17:3 This is eternal life: to know You, the only true God**, and then define eternal life as having knowledge about God. I think eternal life is exactly as the words mean, to have life eternally is this: The only way that you can live eternally is by knowing God and the Father and Christ. Knowing God, knowing the Father and Christ, to me means knowing about intimacy where the Bible talks in 1 John where it says that our fellowship is with the Father and with the Son. What he is basically saying is that this is immortality. This is what it is to never die. If you want to never die and live eternally, have life eternally in you, to be alive and never die.... I don't know how to say it deeper than that.... this is what you need to do. You need to have your fellowship with the Father and with the Son.

This fellowship talks about an intimacy. One of the meanings of fellowship is also intercourse, oneness. So if you can be one with the Father and the Son and know the Father like the Bible says that Adam knew his wife, Eve, and they bore children, that knowing it talks about is a oneness, an intimacy, where Adam and Eve became one with each other. The Bible says that if a husband and wife come together they are one. If a man and woman come together, sexually, they are one body, so the only way that we can become one with God in that sense is in Christ because God came into human flesh, took human flesh, put it at the right hand of the Father and now we are one. That is the only platform from where you can eternally live. That is it.

In Titus, we see that before time began... we can still say that Adam was created outside of time. You will find some people reason like that because Adam was an eternal being. He was created outside of time. If Adam was created outside of time how could God promise somebody eternal life even before time began? The only thing that I can see in this passage is that before time began eternal life was not a given. To live eternally was not a given. What we would say is that in our spirit we just live forever. If we want to say that we need to have scripture for that. You might say, "Bertie, this is a mighty touchy subject. Can't you just preach on the love of God? Can't you just preach on the family life of God and how much He cares, and all those kind of things My goodness, yes! That's what I am talking about. I'm talking about the family life of God. (I think we are going to need many Sundays to explain all of this.) When I look at the family life of God, it explodes into eternal life! That is what it is all about! Remember what the scriptures says that God is the only immortal that dwells an unapproachable life. So there is only one Being who is immortal and that is God. Any other being outside of God is mortal. He cannot live forever. The only way that you can live eternally is if you are braided into this eternal life and it comes and indwells you and then lives in you.

One of the most well known scriptures in the Bible is **John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have everlasting life**. What does the Bible say here? It says that those who don't believe will perish. It doesn't say that they will live eternally. It says that they will perish. That word, perish, means to die, to have your life ended. It says here that He wants us not to die but to live forever. That's what He wants. The dream that God had from the beginning was, listen to this, Paul says in **verse 2** that he, Paul, lives, **In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began**; If you live in hope of eternal life does that mean that you have eternal life?

Let me read it again. I know that I am challenging you. Please, if you don't understand something, please do not just switch off. Study and learn.

I had a guy write something on my Facebook page and somebody actually put a Pinocchio face on there, with a long nose because that guy is lying. When I read everything that I disagreed with, I read it because when a man writes something, he feels persuaded of it to the point that he will publicly make it known. So I want to hear from him what is this thought that is in his heart. The other day I listened to somebody who shared something with me. He asked, "Bertie, is the earth flat or is the earth round?" When I heard that, the first thing that came to my mind was, "This is crazy! How can you say that the earth is flat? Then I went on line just to see because people sent a link. I went on line and read up on it and there are people with doctor degrees, scientists, and all those kind of folks saying the earth is flat. Do you think that a guy with his PhD is just going to risk his neck for nothing to say that the earth is flat? Even if I believe that the earth is round, we can't just write off everything that we think people are not agreeing with us, that everybody is wrong and we cannot listen to anybody until they agree with us. That way you are never going anywhere. That way you could have still been stuck in tithing.

In John it says clearly that those who don't believe will be condemned with a condemnation of death and those who do believe will have eternal life. That is what they will have.

This is the promise that God has given: **Titus 1:**

:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after (leads to) godliness;

:2 (I'm adding in my own words what is said here.) I, Paul (I am) In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

Paul is saying he is in the hope of eternal life... in the hope that eternal life promises, in the hope of eternal life.

When we believe in Jesus, we have eternal life and this eternal life will manifest in our lives in the form of making our bodies immortal. That's what the whole Gospel is about and that is what God has come to preach in Christ. He has come and He gave a message. This is the message that He gave: He took a man and put the sin of the whole world on Him. This man received the sin of the whole world. He died. After He died, what happened to Him? In His death He trusted in His Abba, that His Father will not keep Him in the grave but He will be raised on the third day. Then He was raised from the dead having eternal life. Let us read that:

Romans 1

:1 Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God,

:2 (Which he had promised afore by his prophets in the holy scriptures,)

He has promised before, by the prophets in the holy scriptures, this good news.

:3 Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;

:4 And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:

So He was, concerning His Son Jesus Christ, our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh. So, Jesus, according to the flesh, was the Son of David. He was the Son of God but He was the Son of David but He was not declared the Son of David but Son of God by the resurrection from the dead, in other words, by His immortality. So there was a promise, before time, of a Messiah that will have this immortality and He will be our Messiah and we will be part of His kingdom wherein He will never die and eternally reign. Now we see in **Titus**, Paul says, ***“I am in the hope of eternal life.”***

There are other scriptures that say that we have eternal life now. I am definitely aware of that but I just want to explain to you just the immortality part of this. This is going to take different sessions. Let me put it this way: You need to have eternal life in order to become immortal. If you don't have eternal life which is the life of the Spirit, you will not have the ability to become immortal and you will enter eternal death. As the scripture says, ***“You were taken from dust and from there you will return.”*** We want to use Biblical language, we want to use what the Scriptures say about things and that is what I see. We talk about eternal death here.

Romans 8

:24 For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why does he yet hope for?

:25 But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it.

:26 Likewise the Spirit also helps our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

:27 And he that searches the hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because he makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

If we read on, you will find that he talks about the salvation of the body. He says, “God has given us this hope that He will conform us to the image of His Son. The image of His Son is an undying, immortal human being braided into the family of God wherein this human being shares in a thing only God possesses which is the ability to be alive and never die one day, and live in eternal existence. That is it. He wants to share that with us. He wants to give it to us. You might say, “Why is that a big deal?” Let me explain to you why it is a big deal. My goodness if you take dust... I mean, how dead is dust? You take dust, you take of your life and you burrow it to that dust and when that dust becomes alive it becomes what we call a person or a living soul.

So when you take the breath of life and put it inside dust, you make it alive, you will find every speck of dust that was made alive differs from the other one. Everyone's person is different. Everyone's way of thinking differs. Everything is different. These are individuals. They are people. The Bible says that three thousand souls got saved. Does it say that three thousand, wills, minds and emotions got saved or does it say that three thousand lives are preserved to eternal life? That's what it means, my friends. That's what it actually means.

So here he comes and what he is actually saying is, "I'm granting to dust, life, and when dust comes alive, it will have a will, a mind and emotions. It will have a heart, it will be able to believe. It will even have a body taken from this dust. It will be fully alive and this body or this living soul has all the attributes to contain God. Then God can enter into that human being by that human being believing, trusting, thinking and pondering upon the truth that is inside God. When this man shares in the same Spirit that is inside God, which is the Spirit of kindness, love, temperance, faithfulness, and all of that and the Spirit of life and not death, when that Spirit or that belief starts to indwell this man, you will find that this Spirit gives the promise to this man that you can live eternally and never die.

You might say, "Bertie, this doesn't even make me very happy!" It will not make you happy if you think that it was just a gift from the beginning in the sense that it wasn't even a gift but it was just a given. Let me tell you that the ability to live and never die is the greatest gift that could ever be given to dust. So God will make you alive and when you are alive, He will present Himself to you in the hope that you will like Him, in the hope that you will love Him, because if you love something, what you love enters your heart.

I look at my son, Hendri, he started to do running over obstacles where you carry bags of sand and whatever. He did very well in his first race. There were about 150 to 200 people and he came in fourth over all. It is in his heart. That racing has entered his heart. It determines his life. That is the way it is. My other son started to draw paper sketches and other things and he's quite good at it. It's like it has entered his heart. You find him doing it and you find him reasoning about that. Now when God's love has entered your life, He entered you and His life rubs off on you. As much as a life of an athlete would rub off on my son, when this race, this sport, enters his heart and will determine his thoughts, his emotions, his life, everything that is inside him.

In the very same way when we behold the love of God, when we behold the grace of God, not sin consciousness, not five principles to get God to do something for you. My goodness! But when we behold a man in the Trinity and it enters our belief, do you know what is going to happen to our minds? It's going to be born from this. This Spirit will give life to our mind, our thoughts, our emotions and this energizes us to the point that our bodies will live and never die. I am not saying that we will not die. What I'm saying is, should we die, this Spirit has proven that even should a man die, he can be raised. That is the good news!

We've made the good news that God is not angry with me. My goodness, that was never supposed to be good news! That was supposed to be a given. God is not angry. He is not mad. He has never been angry. He has always been a good God. "But, Bertie, what about the Old Testament?" There you go again. You are on that old horse. Listen my friend, God was never angry! "But what about the Old Testament Scripture?" Listen, the people in the Old Testament didn't know who God was! The bible says in John, *No one has ever seen the Father.* But Jesus declared Him! What does it mean when the scripture says that no one has ever seen the Father? It's very simple! It means that no one has ever seen the Father. That's it! Jesus comes in **John 10** says, *"Everybody that came before Me are thieves and robbers but the sheep could not be led out to true freedom by them."* He wasn't trying to bad mouth anybody but everybody in the Old Testament's view, everybody before Christ's view of who the Father is, would rob you of what the Father really is because they couldn't see Him for who He really is. Go and listen to the writings of Solomon and see what he says. Go and read Ecclesiastes and Job and see what they say. Go and look at the different contradictions there seem to be in the Old. Then you go and look at the prophetic value of all of that and then you begin to understand the light they saw the Father in and you see who Christ is and you see the wonderful knitting together of every passage in the Old Testament as divinely inspired of God.

I may be a little off the point but this is what I want to say: Jesus Christ came. Let us read first John ... this will really put a stamp on it. The gift we have, the gift God promised before time began was, "I promise you that you will live forever and never die." That makes death a given and not life. I hope you understand what I am trying to say. That is why Jesus Christ came and He showed forth the promise that was before time in the presence of death so that we, who continually die, can have the hope of eternal life. Glory to God! My hope is not heaven. Therefore if my hope is not heaven, then my fear is also not hell. If my hope is eternal life, then if I want to be afraid of something it would be death. I know that this can shock a lot of people and I hope I don't lose a lot of people in saying this but this is what is in my heart and I cannot hide it. This is what the Lord has put in me and it makes me happy. In the two to three years that I have been looking at this, it has just established my heart in the unconditional goodness of God.

1 John 1

:1 That which was from the beginning, (What was from the beginning? From the beginning was the promise that we would have eternal life and I am going to prove it to you right now. That was what was from the beginning and what the devil wanted to do was, the lie that was from the beginning was: "You can never die! Don't believe God! You have this immortality thing all sorted out just by the fact that you are a human being." That's not the truth! God promised it. It is something that you can only have from God and if you don't have God indwelling you, how will you have eternal life?)

It says, ***That which was from the beginning: which we have heard,*** (in other words, what have we heard? This promise of eternal life. That is what they have heard.) ***which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;***

:2 For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us; (So where the Father was is eternal life and that eternal life was promised to man. It was promised.. It was something that God came to man and gave man. That is what it is all about. It is eternal life that He promised from the beginning and He took dust and... Let me put it this way: for God to make something have eternal life, it can't just be like, "Bam! You have eternal life!" It doesn't work like that! The only way that you can have eternal life is by standing in a relationship with God, being a being who has a heart that is flooded with the love and the kindness of God. A being that is loved unto immortality. That's the only way you can have eternal life.

The things of this earth, the sky, the stars, and all, I don't care if they are billions of years old, they will not be in existence forever. They can end. We have made eternity anything longer than a hundred years. When we talk about eternal life we are talking about never ending... never beginning, never ending. That's what we are talking about and nothing in creation has that. The only thing that does have that is God Himself and whosoever God indwells and whosoever is born of God. In order for you to be born of God, you need to have a heart persuaded with the same persuasion as God has and it has to be a pure persuasion. That's why God came and took away the sin of all people, brought innocence, life, and then through this innocence He brought us to the place where we can believe and trust and rely upon Him. As we do that we find His life being born in us and we receive His immortality. Therefore we will be called the sons of God.

Just something that might be a bit of a steak to swallow but let me tell you what the Bible defines as the sons of God. God is the only immortal and if you are born of Him, you possess immortality and that is how you are defined as a son of God, by your immortality.

We are all children of the Lord and we are sons in the Spirit but our sonship shall be manifested in immortality. That is what this whole thing is all about. We have made it a heaven and hell thing. We have made it you prosper when you tithe thing. We've made it a sowing and reaping thing. We have made it just being blessed just in this life. Let me tell you something: the things of this world, the body you are in, the car you drive, the house you live in, the friends you have, none of them or anything in this life can ever give you full expression to who you are and what you are in God. The only thing that can give full expression to what God has dreamed for you has been portrayed in the resurrection which is a promise to us which we can have hope to. Glory to God!

The worst thing that can happen to us is not to have eternal life. Then we will have eternal death or die. That is it. That's how I see these scriptures. With this in mind, where it talks about the life here, let us talk about the light, the light of the Gospel, because we want to be enlightened, isn't it.

I'm going to end with John 1. Whenever we see a new foundation revealed, we can build there, glory to God, and it is beautiful. Who knows what can be built on this foundation, Christ. One thing we do know is eternal life and imagine this message of eternal life comes to our relationships, comes to our finances, comes to the way we see things in this world and how we will be protected and blessed. Inside things like having joy unspeakable in the midst of it doesn't matter what happened. Glory to God!

Remember what we said: God before time had a plan and that was to take dust, make it alive and grant eternal life to this dust. The only way we could have eternal life is by having the Spirit of God. The Spirit of God is the atmosphere of heaven, basically the atmosphere in the Trinity which is also a person. Please hear me. This atmosphere, I just use that because there are not words to describe what I believe about the Holy Spirit, but let us use words that are not sufficient but is halfway there. This attitude, basic principle, where God lives, which is love, if that can be exercised towards us and be on us and be poured out on us, meaning if we can receive the love of the Spirit, the kindness that God has towards us, God will love us to a place where our mind, our bodies is so energized with His goodness that we enter into immortality. Glory to God! That's what God has done when He decided for us to have.

This being then didn't trust God that He can give eternal life. He thought, "I already have this and all I need to do is just live right and maintain this life, kind of a thing, and I can have it by my own ability. Then what God promised this man will happen if he eats of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, happen to him and he entered into death. But what God said was, "I will not keep you in the state where you are dying but you can never come to the place of actually dying. That's why he said to Adam, in the state of misery, "I will not give you access into eternal life." In other words, what He said was, "I cannot have you eternally live in misery." That's why He closed the gate to the Garden and didn't allow him eat of the tree of life, lest he lives forever! Isn't God good!

My father-in-law passed away a few weeks ago. He was really suffering. When he passed away, that death was mercy. It was mercy because he was old, he was dying, he was suffering. One might say, "But mercy would be if he just got healed or something like that." Let me tell you that in his case I am happy that he has passed away. I'm missing him. He was a friend to me. He was a wonderful man, such an awesome person, but I couldn't see him suffer like that. I would rather say that in that suffering they could keep him alive with a machine but my mother-in-law said, "We don't want him to continue to suffer." He had a heart attack. They got him back again and then it was basically decided that we are just going to leave it. She sat there, fellowshiped with him, chatted with him, until he passed away. What a grace! What a mercy!

God was merciful when He saw Adam enter into a place where his mind would be troubled, flooded with fear, anxiety, always doubting God, fighting with Eve, children killing each other, living in this eternal misery. He said, "I cannot grant that to be eternal. I cannot see My people being tortured eternally in this darkness of the devil and his mindset. I'd rather incarnate that darkness and bring a message of hope to them that they can believe again unto Me and give them eternal life." That is why He said, "I will first remove all their sin. If I can remove all their sin, they can be clean." Now they can have access into eternal life. They can enter eternal existence in the platform of innocence which was given to all! Alleluia! So unless He first came and made you innocent, and I'm not just talking about forgiven, I'm talking about innocent. If He couldn't come and make you innocent, you could not have access to eternal life because eternal life would be eternal torture. That's what it is so He made you innocent. Now when we have access to eternal life, and we don't want eternal life and we don't have that mindset, that belief, indwell us, how will our bodies live forever? They can't. They will die. That's what will happen but listen to what John 1 says:

John 1

:1 In the beginning was the Word, (What word was in the beginning? We just read the word. What word was in the beginning? Let's read the word again of the word that was in the beginning. What word was in the beginning? The very same John writing, *1 John, That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;*

In the beginning was the word or the promise of life. It was the concept of "I am going to give life to people."

:2 The same was in the beginning with God. This concept of God making things alive was in the beginning with God and that is who God is. He is life giving.

:3 All things were made by him; (This concept of God giving life was from the beginning. In this Word, this Word came and dwelled among us. This message came and dwelled among us. That's what happened.) **and without him was not any thing made that was made.** (It's talking about the person of Jesus)

:4 In him was life; (In Jesus was life) **and the life was the light of men.**

:5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

:6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.

:7 The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.

:8 He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.

:9 That was the true Light, which lightens every man that comes into the world. Glory to God!

So he says here that there is something that is going to enlighten you. What is going to enlighten you is

the life that is in Jesus. What is the life in Jesus? What would enlighten us? What will enlighten us so much that we can have so much life, we can be beholding so much love, so much kindness, so much innocence that it excites our bodies, it excites our minds, to the place of immortality. What can that be? It can only be when we see a man that became sin, my sin, died my death, and was revived and is seated at the right hand of the Father. When we behold a human in the Trinity as our life, it is the full manifestation of the love of God towards man and it gives you immortality. It excites you to that! Glory to God!

Well, Church, we are going to preach a lot about this. It's going to change so many things in this life! I want to tell you that the good news is this: Death was abolished and life and immortality came to light! Glory to God! We can now behold a man seated in the Godhead possessing immortality with the promise that that immortality and that eternal life, we have the hope of that eternal life. In the return of Christ what will we see? We will see, we will explode, into that immortality. What will explode with us is creation into that immortal life. We are beholding a creation that dies. Imagine how one looks that cannot die because we have dominion over this. So when Christ, who has dominion over all of these things, and over us, and when He comes and explodes His kingdom of eternal life into this world, we will be glorified and when we are glorified, that which we have dominion over, or in other words, which is under our effect or what we have effect on, which is this nature, it will co-explode on account of what is happening in us and we will so live with God! Glory to God!

This is so much better than going to heaven! It is something much more splendid. It has a grandeur to it that supersedes the human mind. The natural or carnal mind has something that is born from God that we have never thought about that the devil wanted to steal from us but I want to tell you that God made a promise from before time and that is that He will give us eternal life and we shall have it. Glory to God!
